

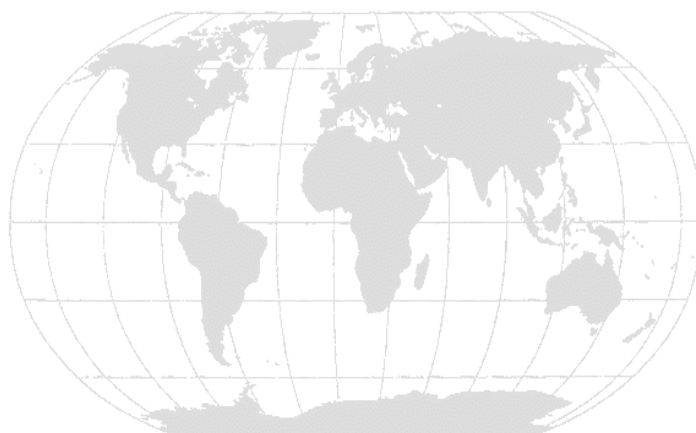

Introduction

A total of 4,133 students from abroad representing 127 countries and 394 faculty and staff from 55 nations claim Purdue University to be their home this fall. Purdue ranks 5th among all US colleges and universities in regard to total international student enrollment, 1st among all US public institutions, and 1st in the Big Ten. The total international student body comprises 11% of the total number of enrolled students, the highest percentage ever in the history of the University.

The fall 1999 international enrollment includes:

- the largest ever international undergraduate student enrollment (1,817) or 5.9% of the total undergraduate student enrollment
- the largest ever international freshmen 1 enrollment - 358 students
- the largest ever international graduate/professional student enrollment (2, 316) or 37% of the total graduate/professional student enrollment
- the largest number of new international students (1,298) in the history of the University

The total number of international undergraduate students increased by more than 15% for the fourth consecutive year. Since fall 1995 the total has increased by 152% (1995- 721; 1999- 1,817). Of particular interest is the fact that international freshmen have increased by nearly 160% during the same time period (1995- 136; 1999- 358).

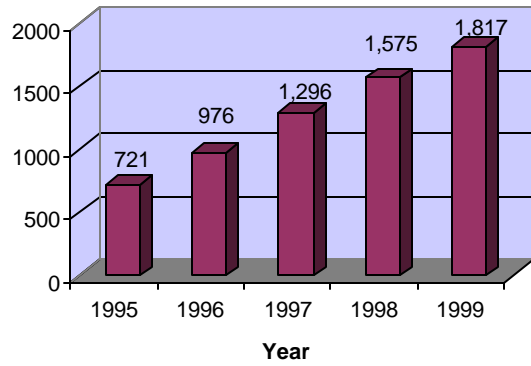
India ranks first (710) in total enrollment. This year is the first time since 1986 that China has not ranked in the top position.

China is second in total international enrollment (628) followed by South Korea (418). Students from Indonesia (276), Taiwan (243), Malaysia (165), Turkey (140) and Pakistan (113) are the only other countries with more than one hundred students. Japan (87) and Singapore (87) round out the top ten. Thirty-one countries are represented with 20 or more students. Approximately 70% of the total international student population is from Asia. The Schools of Engineering, Science and Management continue to be the most popular schools among students from abroad.

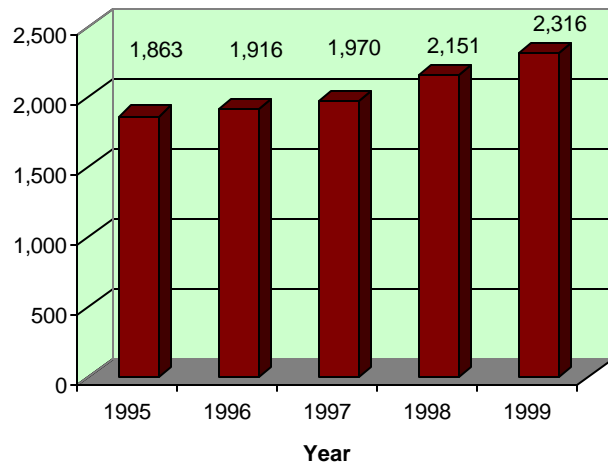
China (64), India (63), Canada (27), South Korea (25), Germany (21), France (17), Italy (16), Spain (16), United Kingdom (14) and the Netherlands (10) are the top ten sending countries for international faculty and staff. The Departments of Chemistry (44), Biological Sciences (40), Medicinal Chemistry & Molecular Pharmacology (23), Horticulture (20), Mechanical Engineering (17) and Computer Sciences (17) employ the greatest number of scholars from abroad.

1995-1999

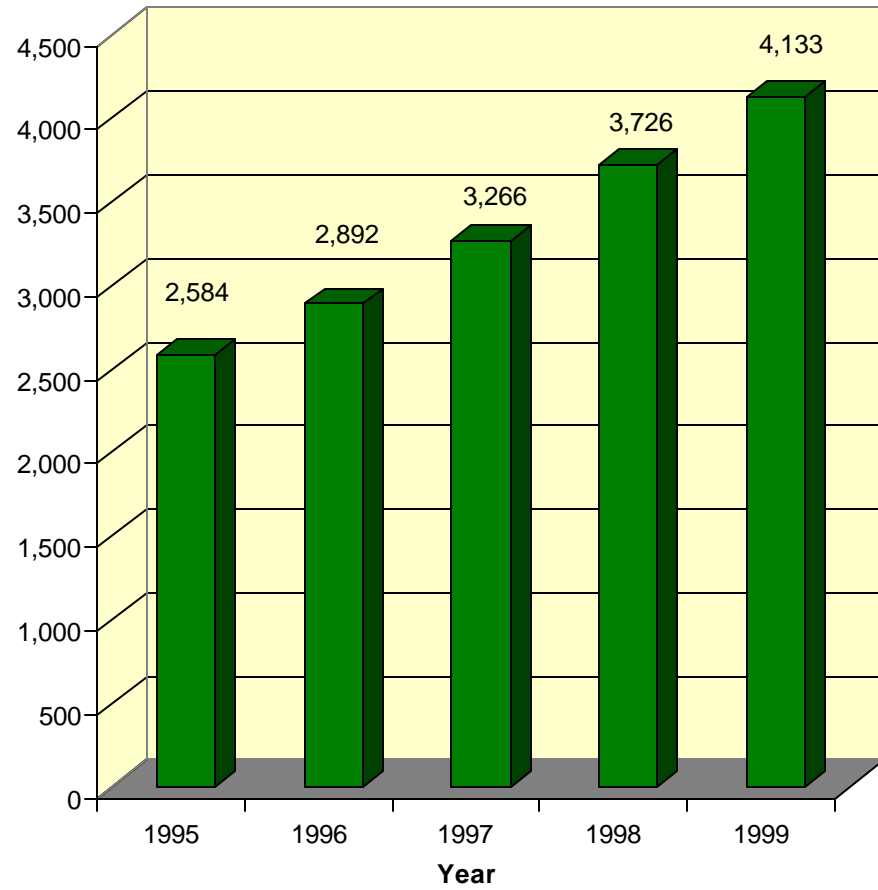

Total International Student Enrollment



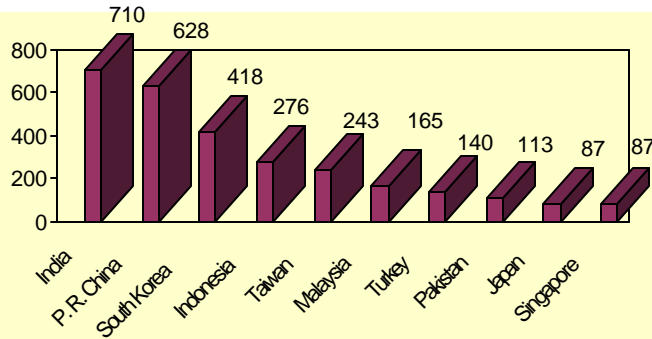

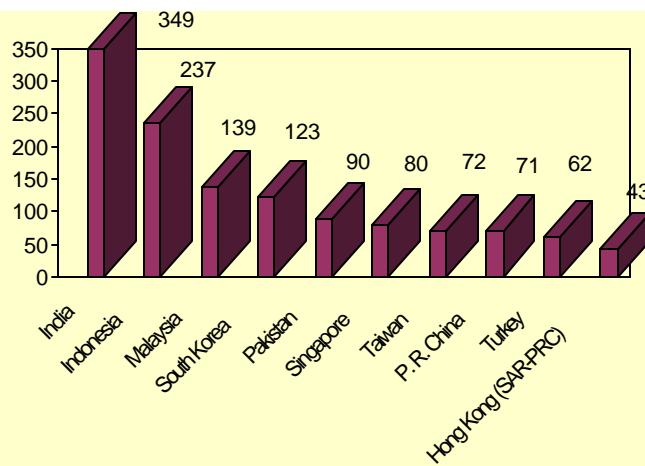

TOP TEN COUNTRIES BY TOTAL, UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL ENROLLMENT

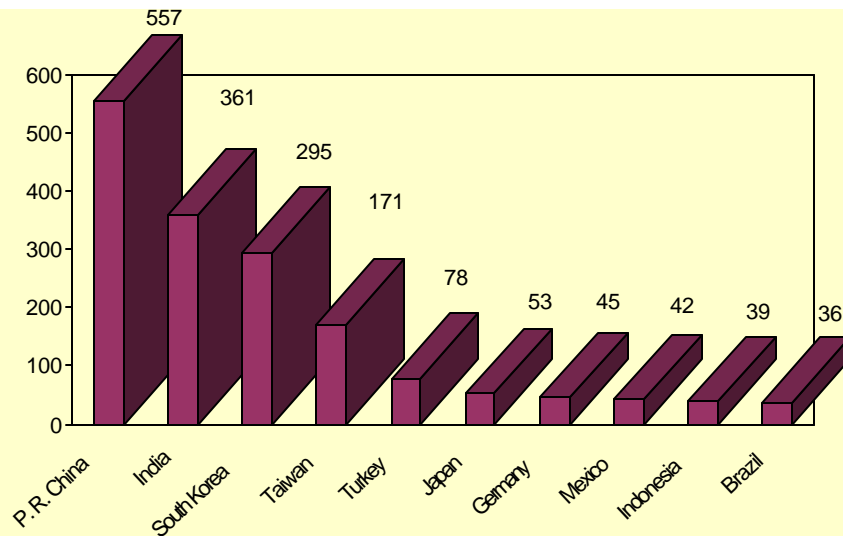
Top Ten by Total Enrollment



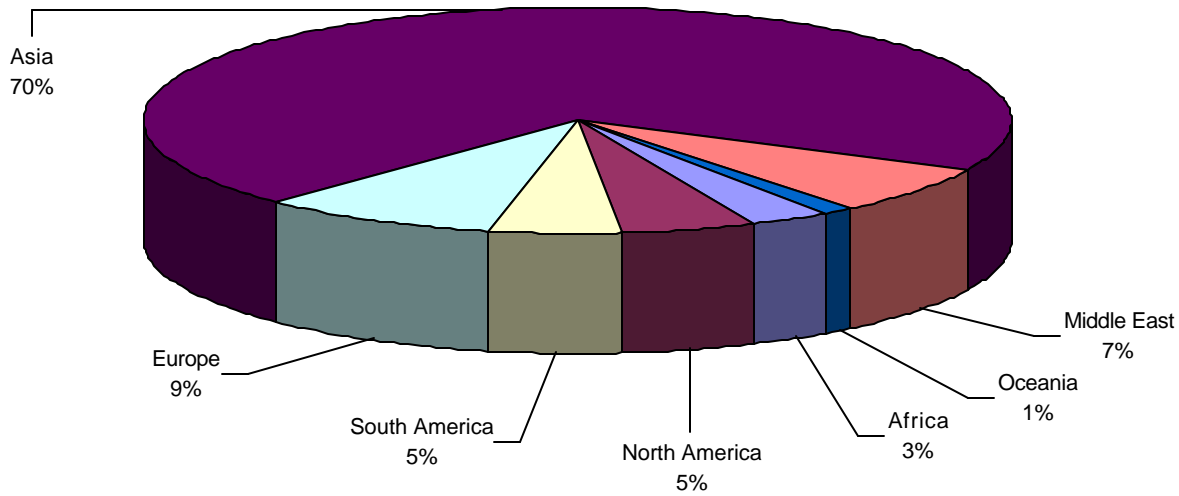
Top Ten by Undergraduate Enrollment



Top Ten by Graduate and Professional Enrollment

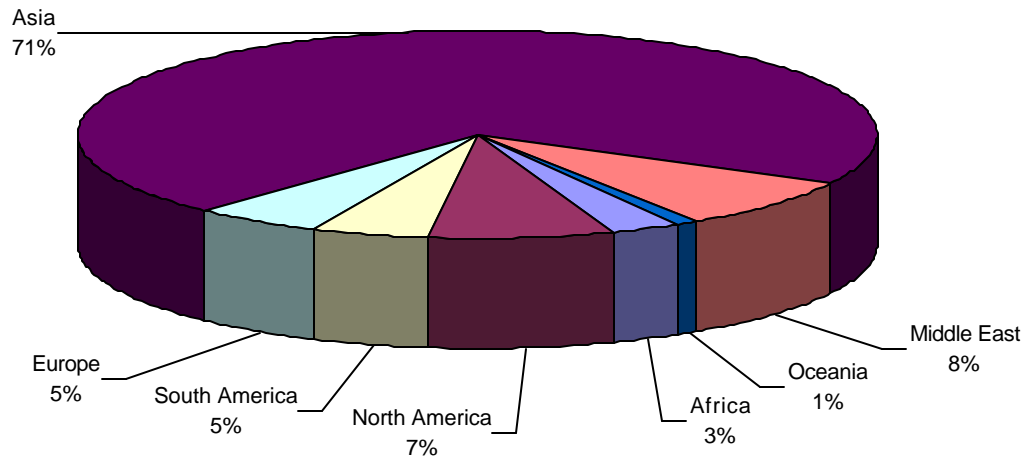


TOTAL ENROLLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC REGION



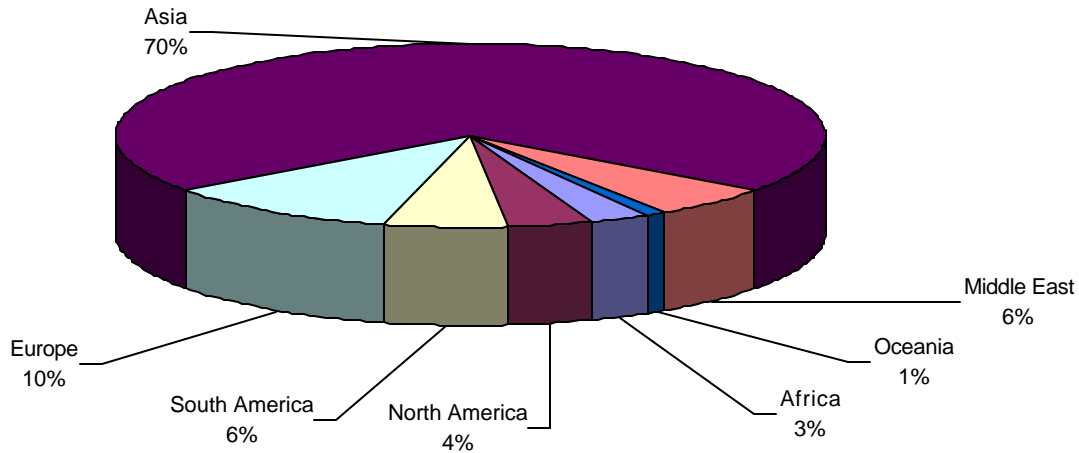

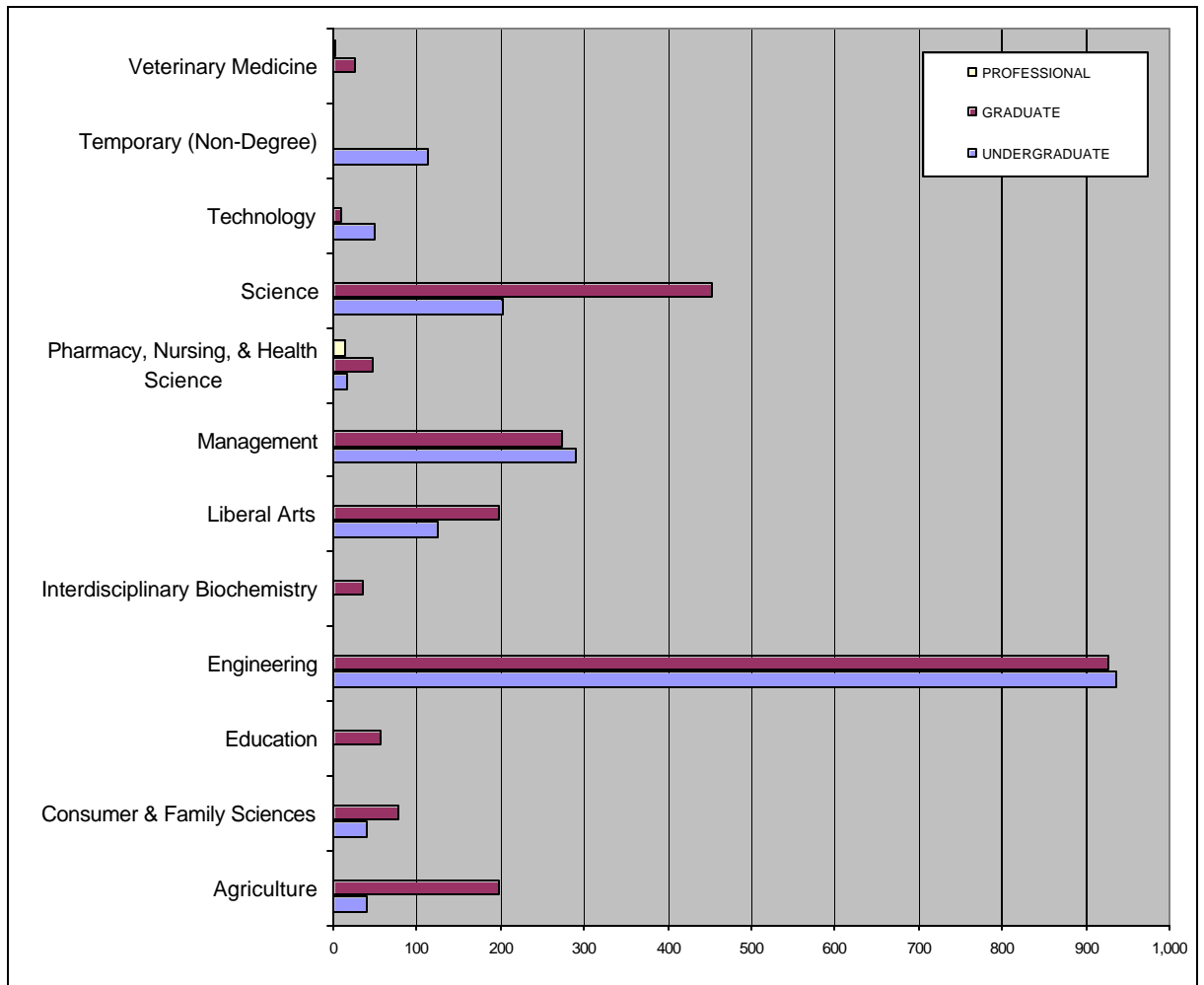
GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL ENROLLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC REGION

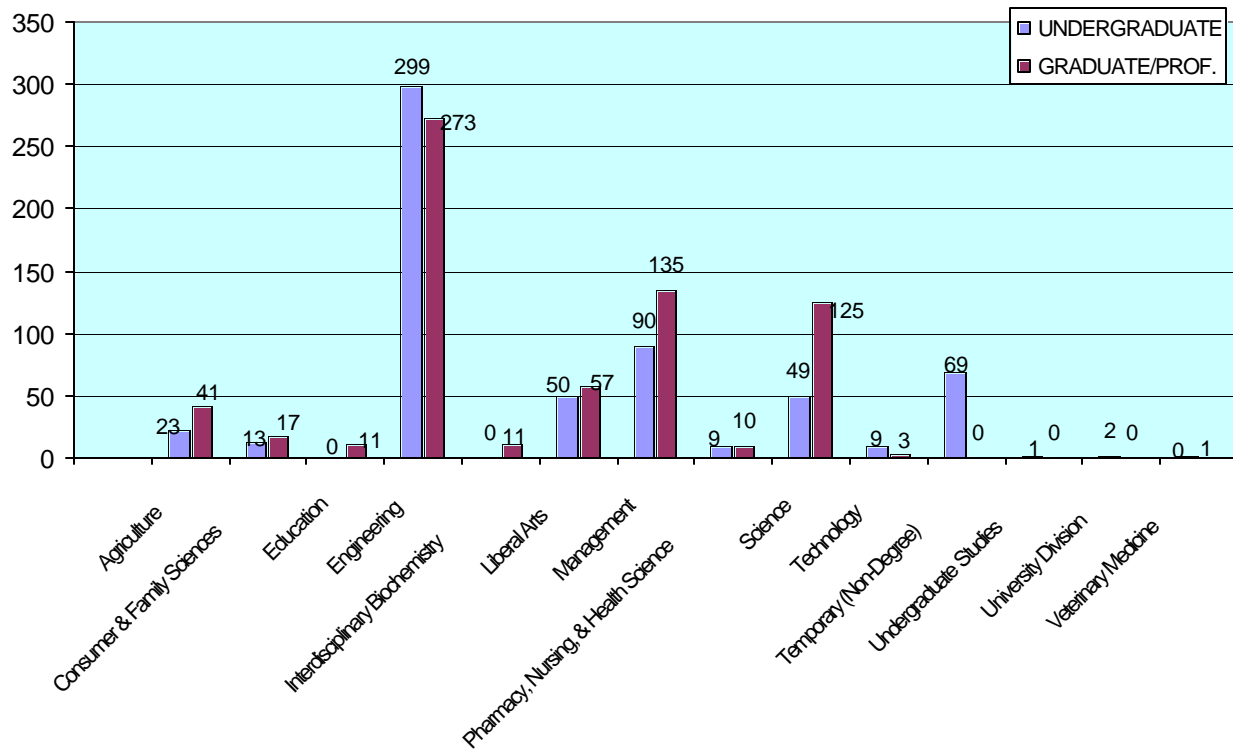
